

TRAVEL POLICIES

Once you check into the hotel, you are under the supervision of NC Elite Volleyball Club personnel. Be on time for team meetings/arrival requirements/playing and work assignments.

You may not check into the hotel until an NC Elite staff member has arrived. If you arrive early, you must stay with your family until the designated check-in time. You should arrive to tournaments fed and hydrated.

Playing volleyball is the primary focus of tournaments. Teams will be able to eat three meals a day, and get a good night's sleep. Any social activities or outings are second to volleyball.

Players will be in rooms of three or four people from their team.

Be appropriate in your word choices, volume, actions, and how you are dressed. If you are not on the volleyball court, you should be wearing something more than just spandex.

Treat your teammates, coaches, parents, officials, and opponents with respect.

If you ever need to leave your team for any reason, you must receive permission from your coaches in advance.

Be in a group of three any time you leave your team. You may not leave the hotel without permission and an adult.

Do not go to anyone's hotel room except for your own, your chaperone's, or your parent's. Do not let anyone except your teammates into your hotel room. Siblings and friends may not be in team rooms.

Do not share our hotel or any room numbers with anyone but your coaches and parents. Keep adjoining doors locked and keep your door closed and locked (no door propping)

NC Elite enforces USAV policies regarding drug, alcohol, and tobacco use. Vaping of any kind is also prohibited and grounds for immediate dismissal from an event and possibly being removed from your team and NC Elite.

If you break something, the cost to fix it will be charged to your account.

Clean up after yourselves at the tournament venue and in the hotel.
